
AVID Two and Three Column Notes

In order to prepare students to take notes in middle school using the Cornell Notes format, students in AVID elementary are taught to take notes using the two and three columns format. These notes help students to process the information they are learning and make connections with this new learning. Some examples of these are below:

Three column notes

vocabulary	meaning	synonym
Ex. challenging	hard to do	difficult
prefix	meaning	examples
Ex. re-	do again	review, retry
math Problem	show the work drawings	answer
Ex. $2 + 1 =$	$** + * = ***$	3

Two column notes

state	capital
Ex. California	Sacramento
Shape name	Shape drawing
Ex. rectangle	
quote	meaning
Ex. "Never give up"	Don't quit, keep trying, persevere
