

On behalf of the students we serve, I invite you to share your thoughts about our school and district. We want to know what you think we do well and what suggestions you have to benefit our students. We will use this input to set priorities in the new 2020-2023 Ontario-Montclair School District Local Control and Accountability Plan.

In a few weeks, you will receive an email to participate. **Beginning on February 19, 2020** you can add and rate thoughts you have about two simple questions at your own pace until the exchange ends on March 15, 2020. We encourage you to return to the website to review your answers and discover the results at any time. All thoughts and ratings shared during an exchange are confidential. By participating, your thoughts and ratings will be shared with others but your identity will remain private. We do this to get a sense of the shared values and priorities of our school and our community and while we share your thoughts, your identity is never publicly linked to those thoughts.

To ensure participation in sharing your thoughts, on February 19 you will receive an email invitation to participate through <u>lcap@omsd.net</u> In the meantime, please ensure you check with the front office to review the email you have on file. If you are a parent or community member without an email address, please stop by the school or district office to receive a paper survey. Submit your survey to the school or district no later than March 16, 2020.

Not only are you guiding the decision-making process, but you are also allowing our school to maintain its tradition of being a school that strives to achieve a world class education for your child.

Winter Cold/Flu Season Tips

The winter cold/flu season is upon us, but there are a few simple things you can do to protect yourself and your family and reduce the risk of infection.

For precautionary measures, please remember to:

- Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your face (especially your eyes, mouth and nose).
- Children who have fevers and coughs or any other flu-like symptoms should stay home until they are symptom-free for 24 hours without medication.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick. If you are sick, keep your distance from others to protect them from getting sick too.
- If you or your child needs to cough or sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue and throw the tissue away immediately. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve or elbow, not your hands.
