Attention parents, the new Dashboard results are out! The California School Dashboard provides parents and educators with meaningful information on school and district progress so they can participate in decisions to improve student learning. The California School Dashboard goes beyond test scores alone to provide a more complete picture of how schools and districts are meeting the needs of all students. To help parents and educators identify strengths and areas for improvement, California reports how districts, schools and student groups are performing across state and local measures. For state measures, performance is based on two factors: current year results, and whether results improved from the prior year.

Results with the arrow towards the colors on the left are lower performing and those with the arrow towards the colors to the right are higher performing. As you can see in the graphic above, Corona Elementary increased slightly in both English-Language Arts and Mathematics resulting in Yellow in both academic areas. The Suspension Rate was maintained resulting in a Green indicator. There was no year-to-year data on English Learner Progress due to the new English Proficiency exam (ELPAC). Lastly however, Corona's Chronic Absenteeism rose slightly to 9.9% resulting in an Orange indicator.

Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10% or more of days enrolled. This translates to 18 days or more absent in a school year. Unfortunately, nearly 1 in 10 Corona students falls into this category. Without question, this lost instructional time affects a student's academic achievement.

Please speak with your son or daughter, and commit to the attendance expectations we've set forth. We need your help, parents. If we "Strive for Less Than Five" absences, we can make a difference in our other indicators, such as English-Language Arts and Mathematics. Thank you in advance for starting the year 2020 on the right foot and helping Corona and your student soar to new heights.
