The 2020 Census is Coming!

United States[®] Census 2020

The 2020 Census is coming and we want to ensure that all of our students are counted. In the 2010 Census 1 million children were not counted. This directly impacts funding to our communities and schools including Title I grants, Special Education grants and other state grants, so this count is important.

Your responses to the 2020 Census are safe, secure, and protected by federal law. Your answers can only be used to produce statistics—they cannot be used against you in any way. By law, all responses to the U.S. Census Bureau household and business surveys are kept completely confidential.

The 2020 Census will follow this procedure:

- March 12-20, 2020 residents will receive a mailing from the Census Bureau with website information and a code to use to complete the simple census paper work electronically by April 3. **Parents will have access to the computer lab at Corona on Tuesdays (1:30-2:30pm), Thursdays and Fridays (2:40-3:40pm) during March 12-April 3.**
- If a family does not complete the online survey by April 3, they will be mailed a paper survey to complete.
- If a family does not complete the paper survey, someone will knock on their door to assist with the survey completion.

Parent Conferences Week March 16-20

We will be holding parent conferences during the week of March 16-20. All students in grades K-6 will be dismissed at 12:45 pm daily during parent conferences week. TK and preschool will have their regular schedule. Teachers have sent home letters asking parents to sign up for a parent conference. It is important that parents make every effort to attend a conference with their child's teacher. At this conference your child's teacher will review with you your child's report card for the second trimester and share important information about how your child is progressing and how you can help your child at home. Teachers will also share how your child is performing on assessments including Reading Inventory (RI) for reading comprehension, progress on books read and points earned in Reading Counts, district math benchmarks, SBAC testing, and foundational reading assessments. We appreciate the support of our families working in partnership with us.
