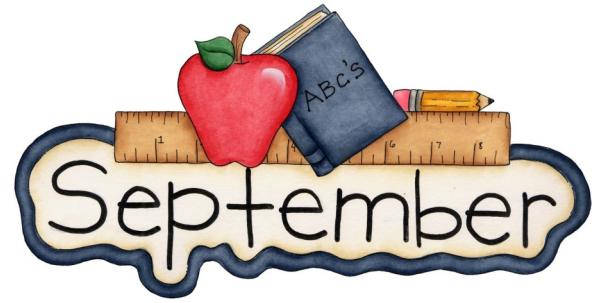

Strive for Less Than Five

One of the most reliable predictors of school success is regular attendance. Absences for any reason result in lost instruction time. We know that students who fall behind often become discouraged learners. It is our hope that we can work together to encourage your child's regular attendance and success at school. **Please remember that your child is expected to be in his or her classroom by 8:00 a.m.** The first bell rings at 7:55 a.m. giving your child 5 minutes to line up, retrieve homework, etc. Class activities start promptly with morning class time and opening activities. Please make every effort to schedule medical and dental appointments after school when possible, to avoid checking your child out from school early so that s/he will not miss instruction. Research indicates that students that have excessive absences are less successful in school. Please do your part to ensure students ***Strive for Less Than Five*** absences this 2019-20 school year.
