Thank you to all of our families for all of your support in following all of our safety guidelines and school procedures. Here are a few reminders to help keep our students safe and at school every day.

* Please remember to be on time at dropoff and pickup. The morning bell rings at 7:45 am daily. Students that are not in their seats at 7:50am when the tardy bell rings will be marked tardy.

* Please only use the crosswalks to cross the street before and after school. Students should not be crossing the street outside of the crosswalk to get to a parent on the other side of the street. Please help keep our students safe by walking them across the street.

*Any students exhibiting COVID symptoms should not come to school. Please screen your students before sending them to school in the morning. Any students exhibiting symptoms will be screened by our health office and sent home as a precautionary measure.

Reading Intervention ~ Mrs. Harrison, Interventionist

We are excited this year to have added a reading intervention team at Del Norte. Mrs. Harrison and two aides, Ms. Jo and Ms. Katya, will be providing additional support for grades 1st-3rd to accelerate reading acquisition for some of our students. We have used iReady diagnostic data to determine who qualifies for these supports. These groups will be provided explicit reading intervention for 30 minutes, daily. Data will be collected regularly to monitor student progress towards mastering foundational skills. The intervention team will be communicating with students, teachers and parents regarding the students' progress. We are so excited to have this additional resource and can't wait to see our Thunderbirds SOAR to new heights this year in reading!
