Dear Edison Families,

We are excited to have adopted Accelerated Reader (AR) as our independent reading program this year. Trimester I was our initial implementation period with students and teachers, and we are hoping to refine our implementation during Trimester 2 by bringing parents on board to support our program implementation. Below are some guidelines on the program and how you can help support your child's reading growth this year.

During Trimester I all students took a STAR assessment which determined their independent reading level. Once students had their independent reading level, they were encouraged to successfully read books and take "AR Quizzes." Based on how they do on these quizzes, they earn points towards their Trimester goals. During the Trimester I earned an average of 15.6 points, answered 78% of their quiz questions correctly and successfully passed 7,244 quizzes!

We hope with your support, the program will grow and continue to foster student successful independent reading practice. During parent conferences you should have received the web link below with your child's username/password to enable you to access your students AR portal:
