## A Message from the Principal...

September is here, and we are approaching the halfway point of our trimester which ends on October 31<sup>st</sup>. Now is the time Kingsley begins to add our enrichment opportunities including after school music, homework club, sports, and more. Our goal is that each Kingsley student will find at least one activity (during the day or after school) to join during the year.

On September 4<sup>th</sup> we will have our first School Site Council meeting for the year. We'd like to welcome our new parent representatives Karla Montoya, Diana Vazquez, and Daniel Carrillo. They join Alejandro Reyes and Jazmine Meza who are completing the second year of their terms. School representatives are Mrs. Esparza, Ms. Loya, Mr. Machado, Mr. Sandoval and myself. This important group develops, approves and monitors our School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). All members of our school community are invited and welcome to attend.

Kingsley has started to provide specific, targeted acceleration and intervention for our students in kindergarten through sixth grade based on their levels and needs. Last month we started our Universal Access time for reading and mathematics where we will be able to provide our students with data-informed support. We appreciate the support our families provide our students at home- especially ensuring students read at least 20 minutes per night. Your help in getting every lion to school every day, on time, will make a huge difference in their academic achievement.

Thank you for your continued patience as we adjust to our new arrival procedures. Our risk management and transportation departments have completed one observation and plan to return again this month with additional suggestions. In the meantime, we appreciate those who wait patiently in line to turn into our traffic circle, have students exit the car as soon as they pull forward into the circle and come to a complete stop, and remain in the car as students exit the vehicle. There is no parking at any time in our traffic circle before school. Making only right turns at the circle exit will also keep things moving smoothly. Drivers may use the bus zone for unloading (no parking, please) starting at 7:15. We also encourage parents to take advantage of our free breakfast starting at 7:15 to avoid the heavy traffic from 7:30-7:40. Student safety is our top priority!

Kingsley Elementary is a PBIS school, and we teach our students how to follow "The Big Three" expectations of being **respectful**, treating others the way I want to be treated; **responsible**, doing the right thing even when no one is watching; and **compassionate**, what hurts my brother or my sister hurts me. This teaching began the first day of school with a stronger push forward at our PBIS Kick-Off assembly and continued with rotations around campus as staff members instructed students on how to show "The Big Three" all over Kingsley. We truly appreciate our families' support in reinforcing our expectations at home too.

As a reminder we offer free breakfast for all students in kindergarten through sixth grade from 7:15-7:35; second chance breakfast is offered again during morning recess. On minimum days that we dismiss at 12:15 to TK/Kinder and 12:30 for first-sixth grade, we will only offer breakfast before school. Thank you all for helping us collect our Alternative Income Forms.
