1 Select a book

- Students select a book at school that interests them AND is within their independent reading level.

2 Read the book

- Know what book your child has selected as their independent reading book
- Ideas for positive interaction with reading
 - Have your child read aloud to you
 - Check for understanding through conversation, not quizzing
 - Read the book with them
 - Read as a family
 - Set a regular time to read, make it positive
 - Read in a special part of the house

3 Take an AR Quiz

- Make sure students finish and understand the book prior to taking a quiz
- Students take an AR quiz at school during school hours
- Goal is for students to average 85% of all questions correctly
- Students earn points towards their Trimester Goal
