GED PROGRAM

PROGRAMA GED



- In-person classes at our site
- Classes are taught in English and in Spanish
- Classes are scheduled Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM-11:45 AM
- Students are taught general content in Math, Science, Social Studies, and Language Arts to prepare them for the GED exam.
- The GED certificate is a high school equivalency for those who never earned a high school diploma.

- *Clases presenciales en nuestro sitio.*

- *Las clases están programadas de lunes a jueves de 8:30 a. m. a 11:45 a. m.*
- *A los estudiantes se les enseña contenido general en Matemáticas, Ciencias, Estudios Sociales y Artes del Lenguaje para prepararlos para el examen GED.*
- *El certificado GED es un equivalente de escuela secundaria para aquellos que nunca obtuvieron un diploma de escuela secundaria.*



REGISTRATION-REGISTRACIÓN

- Classes are offered to OMSD parents and community members of Ontario and Montclair.
- You must be registered through the PEC front office **before** you begin any classes.
- **Enrollment is ongoing**
- Classes are offered in English, Spanish and/or taught in the language that suits the majority of the class audience. Refer to PEC Class Schedule for details.
- If needed, Chromebooks are available to OMSD parents/community members enrolled and attending in PEC courses.

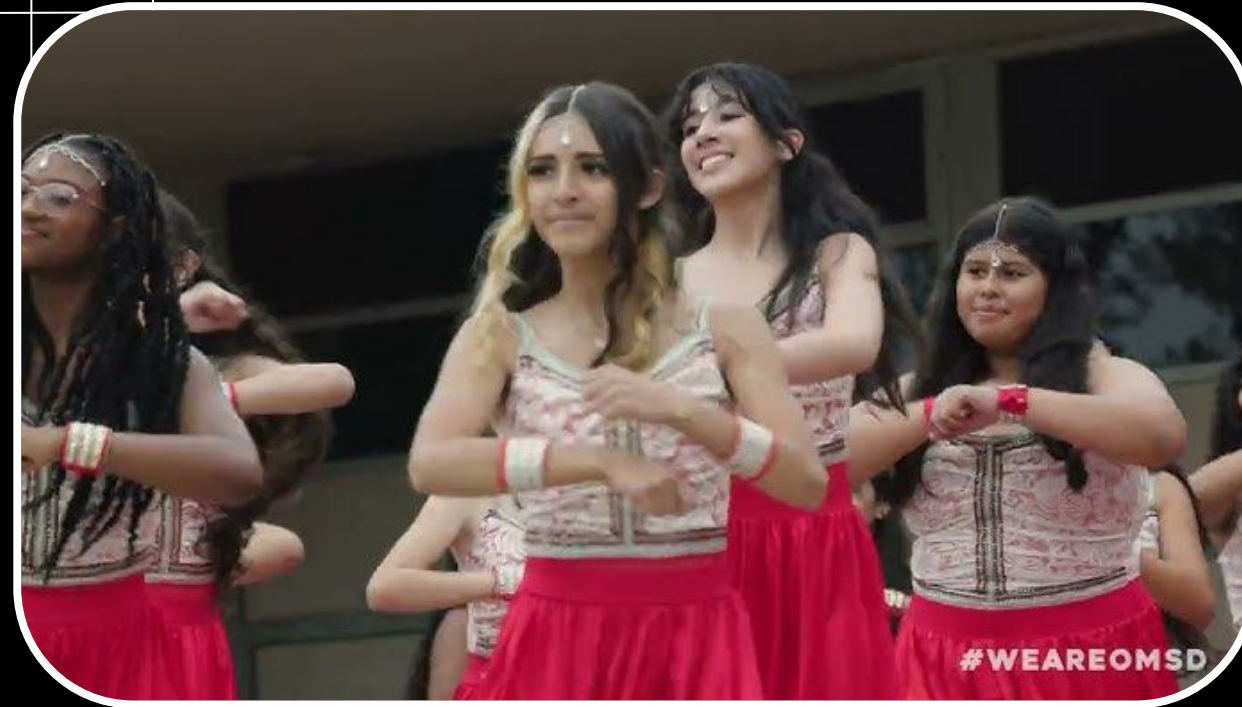

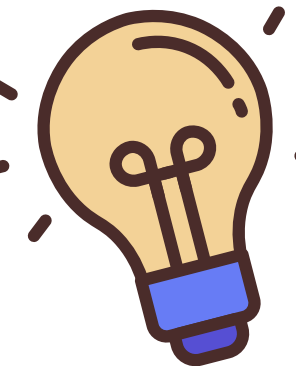

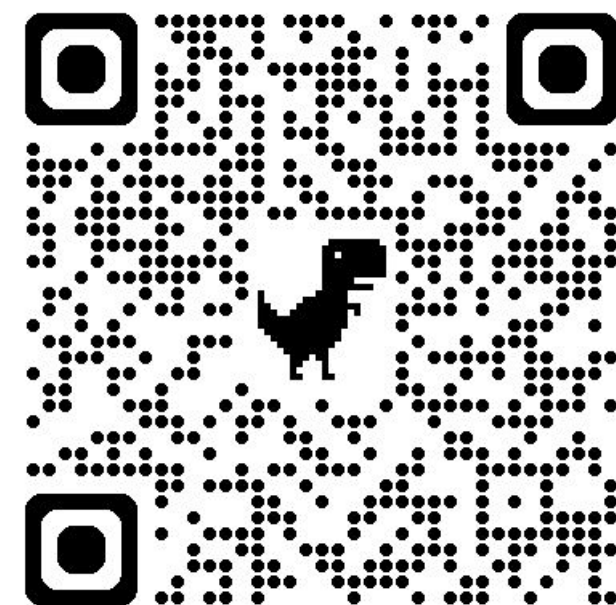

- e• 94.9% average in district
- 97.2% average at Edison
 - Only school at or above 97%!
- 2.3% over 180 days at Edison results in 2,898 more student days at school!

- Students read and take quizzes within level
- Quiz taken during the school day
- Students earn points based on quiz result
 - 70% required to pass
 - Percent correct determines points

Reader

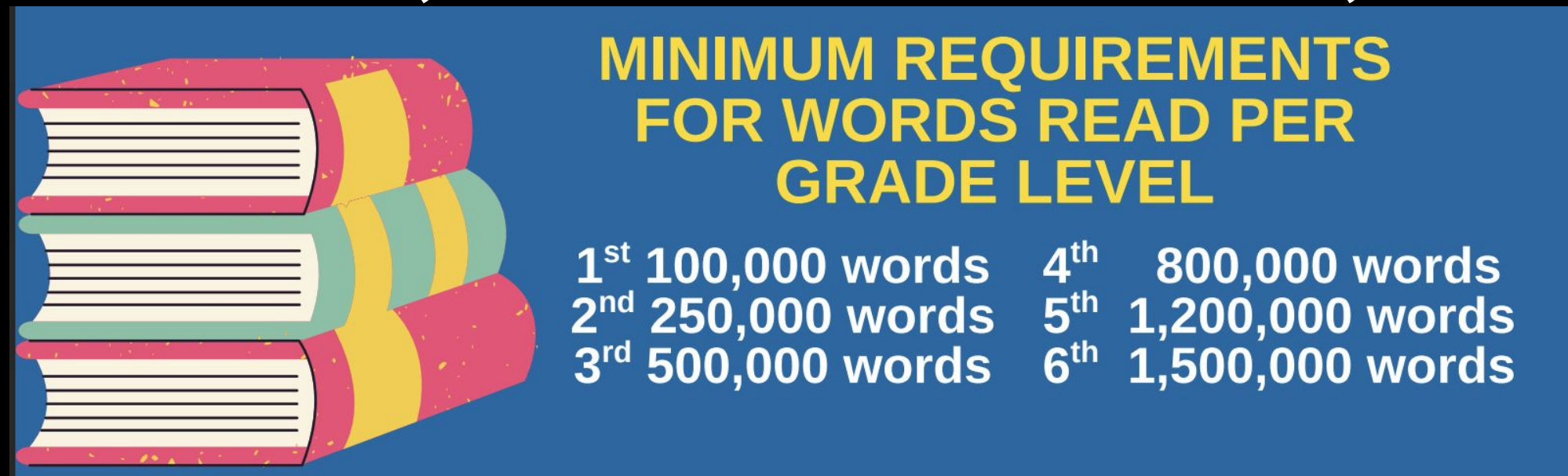
- Based on words read

 - 0% words earned if not passed
