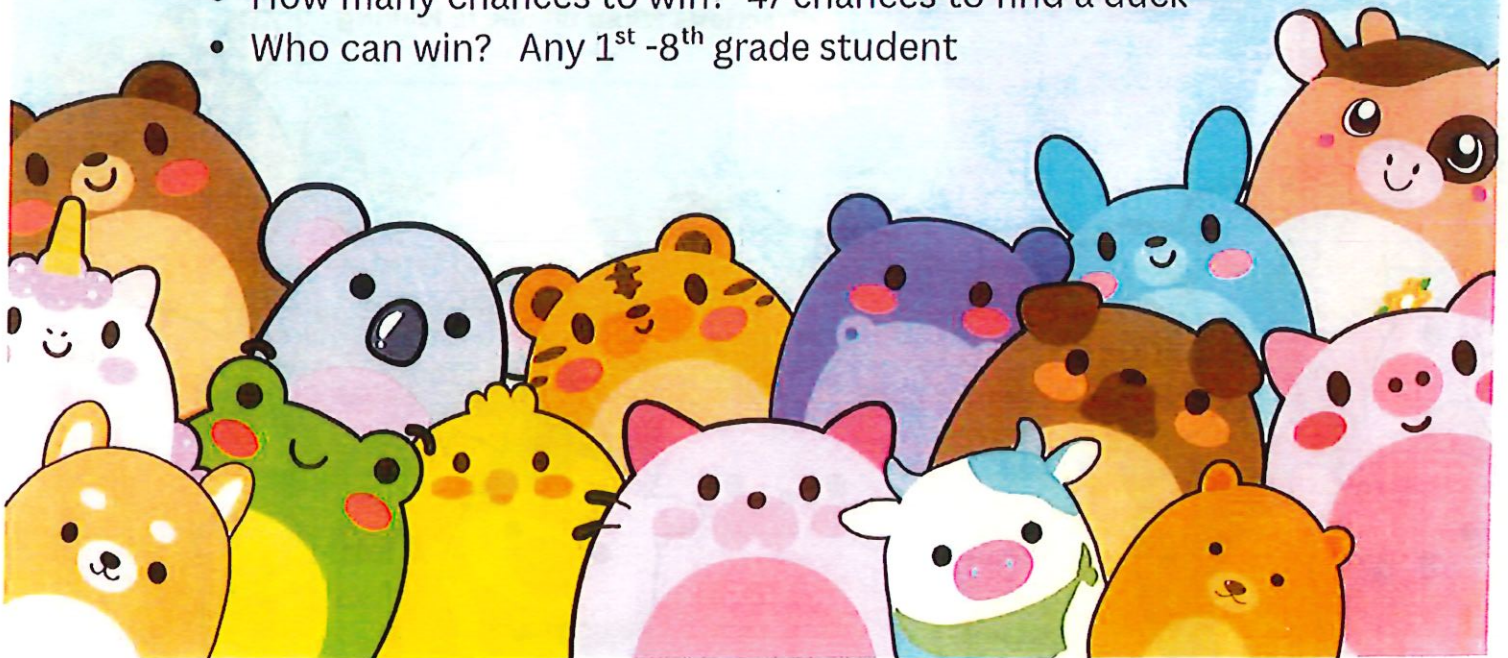
Find Outreach's Lucky Duck to win a Squishmallow

would prevent lost umbrellas.



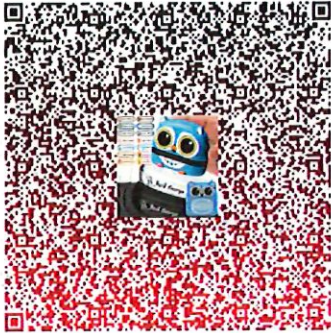

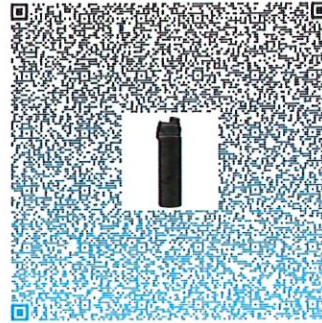

****Last School Year we donated **50 bags** of Lost and Found items.****

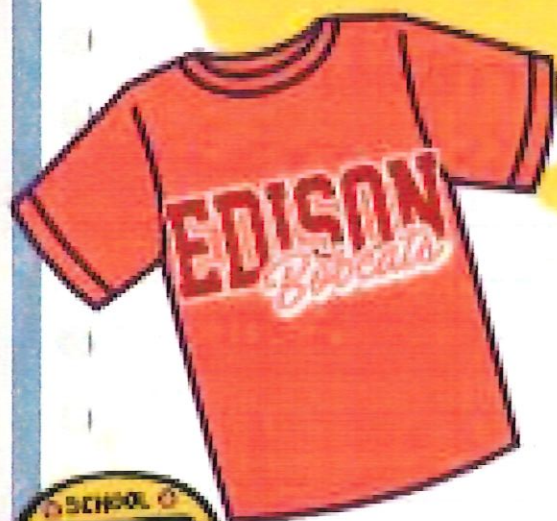
