Parent Conferences: Before


- Talk to students about upcoming conference
- Ask how they're feeling about their progress this year and upcoming exams
- Prepare list of questions:
 - How can I continue to support at home?
 - What is their strength or area to improve?
 - Do they participate and ask questions?
 - Do they use test-taking strategies?

Parent Conferences: During

- Have and honor appointment we are excited to talk about student progress
- Ask student to attend
- Be yourself and ask questions
- Presume positive intentions
- Use the report card as a point of conversation

Parent Conferences: During

- iReady Information
 - Shows results over time
 - Math and ELA
- End of Year Assessment
 - Mid or Above Grade Level
 - Early on Grade Level
 - o 1 Grade Level Below
 - o 2 Grade Levels Below
 - 3 or More Grade Levels Below



Parent Conferences: After

- Talk to your child about the conference
- Be positive and honest about next steps
- Have a support plan in place
- Change to adjust support
- Celebrate successes!
- Let them know you believe in their growth and effort

State Exam Resources

- Students in 3rd 8th grade will test in ELA and Math
 - 5th and 8th grade also test in Science
- Finalizing testing calendar shortly
 - April 21 May 8
 - Testing on Mondays and Fridays
 - Make attendance a big priority
 - Kids do best with their classroom
 - When absent they could feel overwhelmed

- Talk to students about exams and set goals with them
- Focus on processes of doing their best
- We have developed testing strategies to focus on process and not outcome
 - Standard strategies included as handout
 - Grade level specific
 - Communicate with teacher to reinforce strategies

Reread the text. Read for a purpose. Read the question before the passage. Look around in the text for vocabulary. Lip read the text to help you focus. Use the highlighting tool. Use the strikeout tool. Take notes on passages. Prewrite. Make a graphic organizer when writing. Annotate the paragraph. Use RACE for writing responses.	SHOW YOUR WORK! Fold your scratch paper and organize it per question. Circle your answer. Make your own conversion chart when you get your scratch paper. Draw a tape diagram, an area model, or a picture to help. Create a place value chart. Write your multiples. Skip count. Write out your own multiplication chart. Use subtraction to check addition. (STAR)	Not too fast. Not too slow. Just right.
