Help may be available

Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Rights include:

- Immediate enrollment in the school the student last attended (school of origin) or the local school where you are currently staying, even if you do not have all of the documents normally required at the time of enrollment.
- Continue to attend the school of origin, if requested by you and it is in the student's best interest.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of residence or origin.
- Access to programs and services as offered to all other children.

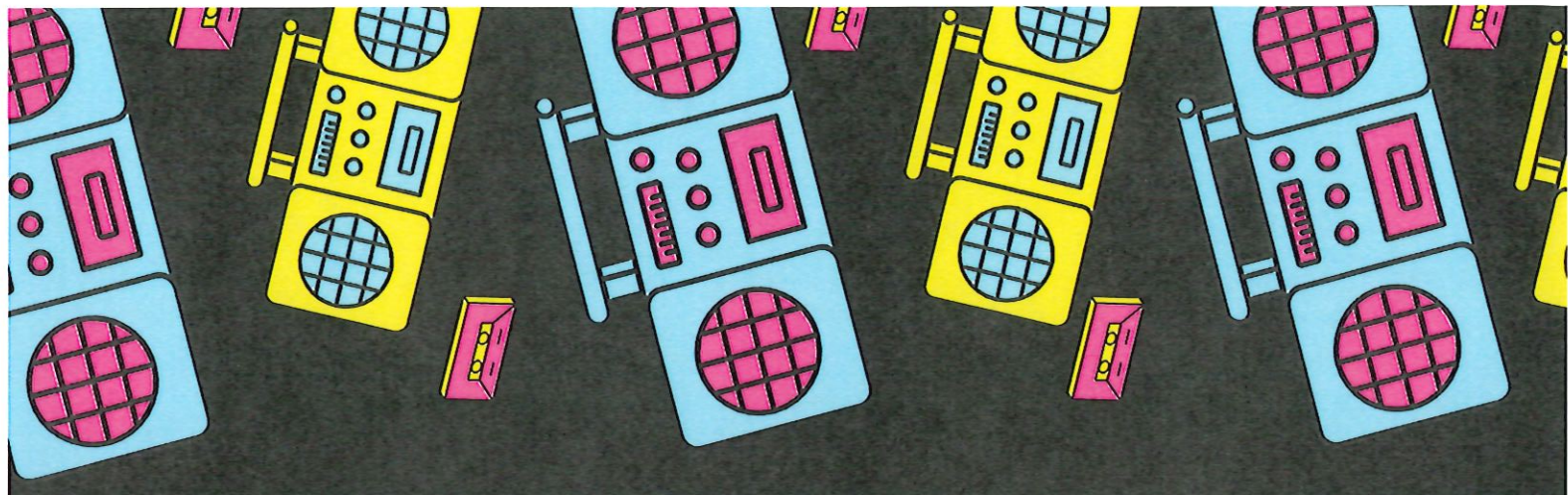
