What are Title I Funds?

Title I provides federal aid to districts and local schools to schools to support children from low-income families.

All OMSD schools are considered Title I

Title I Requirements

Schools must ...

- Inform parents of:
 - Title I and their right to be involved
 - Curriculum, academic assessments and academic proficiency levels.
- Involve parents in:
 - The planning, reviewing, improvement of Title I programs
 - Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA).
- Designate 1% of Title I funds to promote parent involvement

Title I Requirements

Schools must ...

- Annually update and review Parent Involvement Policy
 - Meaningful parent involvement
 - Understandable language and format
 - Build capacity
 - Include a parent compact component
 - Review every other year.

Parent Involvement/Supporting Student Achievement

- Integrate parent involvement opportunities
- Provide information related to school and parent programs, meetings and other activities
- Ensure two-way communication: parent-teacher conferences, access to staff, participation opportunities


CAASPP Proficiency Levels

English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science












iReady #1 - ELA




iReady #1 - Math




Attendance: Historical

For Struggling Students:

Best first instruction, small groups, UA, intervention (pull-out and after-school)

For English Learners:

Best first instruction, in-class ELD supports, newcomer aide, intervention

For Special Education:

Best first instruction, small groups, RSP, Speech, Occupational Therapy, Adaptive PE

(Edison does not have self-contained classes)
