The meeting was called to order at 3:05 p.m.

A quorum was established with 7 members present.

No changes or additions to the agenda were made.

Minutes were distributed from the previous meeting. No revisions were made and on a motion by Mr. Williams (seconded by Mrs. Tamayo) the minutes were unanimously approved.

There was no unfinished business.

VIII. New Business

Agenda Item #1 | Action: Approve Single Plan for Student Achievement

The SPSA was discussed and questions revolved around the continuing support of our intervention room. Edison will continue to fund a bilingual instructional assistant based on student early reading needs. Mr. Gormaz discussed there is a possibility we may come back to the SSC to request an additional Instructional Assistant be funded with Title I funds at the start of the academic year should there be a documented need based on the committee's needs assessment and funding viability. At this point, Mr. Gormaz was recommending the elimination of one Instructional Assistant position in the intervention room. Committee members asked if this would impact a current employee and Mr. Gormaz mentioned it would not as the position is currently being held on a short term contract and the current employee had been scheduled to revert to her previous position.

Mr. Gormaz also proposed having Title I fund a portion of our Student Mentor and two Instructional Assistants. Both positions are related to stakeholder input related to providing social emotional support and teaching to students as well as academic interventions to our most at risk students. Committee members asked about the the priorities of the

intervention room and Mr. Gormaz stated the room is led by a longtime Kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Thomas. The intervention screens all students at the start of the year and they deliver intensive reading intervention prioritizing students in early grades using research based interventions. Students receive this intensive support during Universal Access time for 30 minutes, 4 times per week.

Other initiatives discussed were recommended programs and initiatives that would be funded by discretionary funds and not with Title I funds. Those initiatives included enrichment opportunities through after school clubs, an additional teacher to eliminate the need for combination classes and parent workshops. The initiatives funded by discretionary funding were not included in the SPSA as they are not Title I funded initiatives.

Agenda Item #2 | Discussion: Parent Parking Options

Mr. Gormaz mentioned this is a continuing project that has involved district and city personnel. Currently, the district is not utilizing the interior driveway for buses and has instead been using Sultana. The district is considering changing the curb restrictions. Mr. Gormaz noted he has expressed concerns about moving our buses to Sultana or Sixth Street and the impact that will have on congestion, visibility and general safety when buses use street locations during dismissal. The conversation is continuing as the district and city consider ways to safely utilize the interior driveway which may entail cutting some large branches off a tree near the Sixth Street entrance.

This topic will be revisited at the first SSC meeting of the new year.

IX. Public Comments on Non Agenda Items

There were no public comments on non-agenda items.

X. Announcements

Mr. Gormaz announced that for the coming year, Mrs. Peterson has been promoted to serve as Edison's Assistant Principal and former Edison Principal Mrs. Jennifer Berry will be serving as Edison's Instructional Coach.

VIII. Nuevos temas a tratar

Inciso #1 | (tema de acción): Aprobar el Plan para el Rendimiento Estudiantil (SPSA, por sus siglas en inglés)

Se habló del SPSA y las preguntas giraron en torno al apoyo continuo de nuestra aula de intervención. Edison continuará financiando un auxiliar de instrucción bilingüe según las necesidades de lectura temprana de los estudiantes. El Sr. Gormaz comentó que existe la posibilidad de que regresemos al Consejo del Directivo Escolar (SSC) para solicitar que se financie un auxiliar de instrucción adicional con fondos del Título I al comienzo del año escolar en caso de que haya una necesidad documentada basada en la evaluación de necesidades del consejo y la viabilidad de los fondos. En este punto, el Sr. Gormaz estaba recomendando la eliminación de un puesto de auxiliar de instrucción en el aula de intervención. Los miembros del consejo preguntaron si esto afectaría a un empleado actual y el Sr. Gormaz mencionó que no, ya que el puesto se ocupa actualmente con un contrato a corto plazo y se había programado que el empleado actual volviera a su puesto anterior.

El Sr. Gormaz también propuso que los fondos del Título I financien en parte el puesto de nuestro mentor estudiantil y dos auxiliares de instrucción. Ambas posiciones están relacionadas con las aportaciones de las partes interesadas relacionadas con la enseñanza y apoyo socioemocional a los estudiantes, así como las intervenciones académicas a nuestros estudiantes en mayor riesgo académico. Los miembros del consejo preguntaron acerca de las prioridades del aula de intervención y el Sr. Gormaz dijo que el aula está dirigida por una maestra de kínder desde hace mucho tiempo, la Sra. Thomas. La intervención evalúa a todos los estudiantes al comienzo del año escolar y ellos entregan la intervención intensiva de lectura que da prioridad a estudiantes en los grados primarios que utilizan intervenciones basadas en la investigación. Los estudiantes reciben este apoyo intensivo durante el tiempo de "acceso universal" durante 30 minutos, 4 veces por semana.

Próxima reunión: miércoles, 11 de septiembre, 2024 a las 3:00 pm

Otras iniciativas analizadas fueron los programas recomendados y las iniciativas que se podrían financiar con fondos discrecionales y no con fondos del Título I. Esas iniciativas incluían oportunidades de enriquecimiento a través de clubes extraescolares, un maestro adicional para eliminar la necesidad de clases combinadas y talleres para padres. Las iniciativas financiadas con fondos discrecionales no se incluyeron en el SPSA, ya que no son iniciativas financiadas por el Título I.

Inciso #2 | Discusión: Opciones de estacionamiento para los padres

El Sr. Gormaz menciona que este es un proyecto continuo que ha involucrado a personal del distrito y de la ciudad. Actualmente, el distrito no está utilizando el carril de acceso dentro del estacionamiento para los autobuses y en su lugar ha estado utilizando la calle Sultana. El distrito está considerando cambiar las restricciones de la acera. El Sr. Gormaz señaló que ha expresado su preocupación acerca de mover nuestros autobuses a la calle Sultana o la calle Sexta (6th St.) y el impacto que tendrá en la congestión, la visibilidad y la seguridad general cuando los autobuses utilizan lugares de la calle durante la hora de salida. La conversación sigue mientras el distrito y la ciudad consideran formas de utilizar con seguridad el carril de acceso dentro del estacionamiento que puede implicar cortar algunas ramas grandes de un árbol cerca de la entrada de la calle Sexta (6th St.).

Este tema se volverá a tratar en la primera reunión del SSC del nuevo año.

Article I: Duties of the SSC

The SSC of Edison Academy, hereinafter referred to as the SSC, shall carry out the following duties:

- Obtain recommendations for, and review of, the proposed SPSA from all school advisory committees
- Develop and approve the SPSA and related expenditures in accordance with state and federal laws and regulations
- Recommend the SPSA and expenditures to the governing board for approval
- Provide ongoing review of the implementation of the SPSA with the principal, teachers, and other school staff members
- Make modifications to the SPSA whenever the need arises
- Submit the SPSA Modification Form for governing board approval whenever a material change (as defined in district governing board policy) is made in planned activities or related expenditures
- At least annually evaluate the progress made toward school goals to raise the academic achievement of all students
- Carry out all other duties assigned to the SSC by the district governing board and by state law

Article II: Members

Section A: Composition

The SSC shall be composed of 10 members, selected by their peers, as follows:

- 5 Parents or community members (not serving as employees of the school)
 - Parents and community members shall be elected by a school wide vote where each "household" is entitled to one vote
- 3 Teachers (teacher is defined as a certificated staff member who is assigned a class roster)
- 1 Other school staff member (classified or certificated staff member who does not have a class roster assigned to them)
- The school principal shall be a permanent member of the SSC

*SSC members chosen to represent parents may be employees of the school district so long as they are not employed at Edison Academy.

Section B: Term of Office

SSC members shall be elected for a two year terms. Half, or the nearest approximation thereof, of each representative group shall be elected during odd years, and the remaining number elected during even years. At the first regular meeting of the SSC, each member's current term of office shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

Section C: Voting Rights

Each member is entitled to one vote and may cast that vote on any matter submitted to a vote of the SSC. Absentee ballots shall not be permitted.

Section D: Termination of Membership

The SSC may, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all its members, suspend or expel an elected member. Any elected member may terminate his or her membership by submitting a written letter of resignation to the SSC chairperson.

Section E: Transfer of Membership

Membership on the SSC may not be assigned or transferred.

Section F: Vacancy

Any vacancy on the SSC occurring during the term of a duly elected member shall be filled by a new member selection by nomination in the same group (e.g. classroom teachers, other school staff members, parents or community members, students). A new member selected to fill a vacant seat on the SSC shall serve the remainder office term of the vacant seat.

Article III: Officers

Section A: Officers

The officers of the SSC shall be a chairperson, vice-chairperson, secretary, district parent advisory committee and other officers the SSC may deem desirable.

The chairperson shall:

- Preside at all meetings of the SSC
- Sign letters, reports, and other communications of the SSC
- Perform all duties incident to the office of the chairperson
- Have other such duties as are prescribed by the SSC

The vice-chairperson shall:

- Represent the chairperson in assigned duties
- Substitute for the chairperson in his or her absence

The secretary shall:

- Keep duplicate records of the SSC
- Keep a register of the names, addresses and telephone numbers of each member of the SSC, the chairpersons of school advisory committees, and others with whom the SSC has regular dealings, as furnished by those persons
- Perform other such duties as are assigned by the chairperson or the SSC

Section B: Election and Terms of Office

The officers shall be elected annually by the second meeting of the SSC and shall serve for one year, or until each successor has been elected.

Section C: Removal of Officers

Officers may be removed from office by a two-thirds vote of all the members.

Section D: Vacancy

A vacancy in any office shall be filled at the earliest opportunity by a special election of the SSC for the remaining portion of the term of office.

Article IV: Committees

Section A: Subcommittees

The SSC may establish and abolish subcommittees of its own membership to perform duties as shall be prescribed by the SSC. At least one member representing teachers and one member representing parents shall make up the subcommittee. No subcommittee may exercise the authority of the SSC.

Section B: Other Standing and Special Committees

The SSC may establish and abolish standing or special committees with such composition to perform such duties as shall be prescribed by the SSC. No such committee may exercise the authority of the SSC.

Section C: Membership

Unless otherwise determined by the SSC, the SSC chairperson shall appoint members of standing or special committees. A vacancy on a committee shall be filled by appointment made by the chairperson.

Section D: Terms of Office

The SSC shall determine the terms of office for members of a committee.

Section E: Rules

Each committee established by SSC may adopt rules for its own government not inconsistent with these bylaws or rules adopted by the SSC, or policies of the district governing board.

Section F: Quorum

A majority of the members of the committee established by SSC shall constitute a quorum, unless otherwise determined by the SSC. The act of a majority of the members present shall be the act of the committee, provided a quorum is in attendance (Elementary is 6 for quorum, and Middle school is 7 for quorum).

Article V: Meetings of the SSC

Section A: Meetings

The SSC shall meet on the assigned calendar day established each school year. Special meetings of the SSC may be called by the chairperson or by a majority vote of the SSC.

Section B: Place of Meetings

The SSC shall hold its regular meetings at a facility provided by the school, unless such a facility that is accessible to the public, including handicapped persons, is unavailable. Alternate meeting places may be determined by the chairperson or by majority vote of the SSC.

Section C: Notice of Meetings

Written public notice shall be given of all meetings at least 72 hours in advance of the meeting. Changes in the established date, time, or location shall be given special notice. All meetings shall be publicized in the following venues: Front Office and school website.

All required notices shall be delivered to the SSC and committee members no less than 72 hours of the meeting, personally or by mail (or by email).

Section D: Quorum

The act of a majority of the member's present shall be the act of the SSC, provided a quorum is in attendance, and no decision may otherwise be attributed to the SSC. A majority of the members of the SSC shall constitute a quorum.

Section E: Conduct of Meetings

Meetings of the SSC shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of order established by California EC Section 3147(c), and with Robert's Rules of Order or an adaptation thereof approved by the SSC.

Section F: Meetings Open to the Public

All meetings of the SSC, and of committees established by the SSC, shall be open to the public. Notice of such meetings shall be provided in accordance with Section C of this article.

Article VI: Amendments

An amendment of these bylaws may be made at any regular meeting of the SSC by a vote of a majority of the entire membership of the SSC. Written notice of the proposed amendment must be submitted to SSC members at least 5 days prior to the meeting at which the amendment is to be considered for adoption.

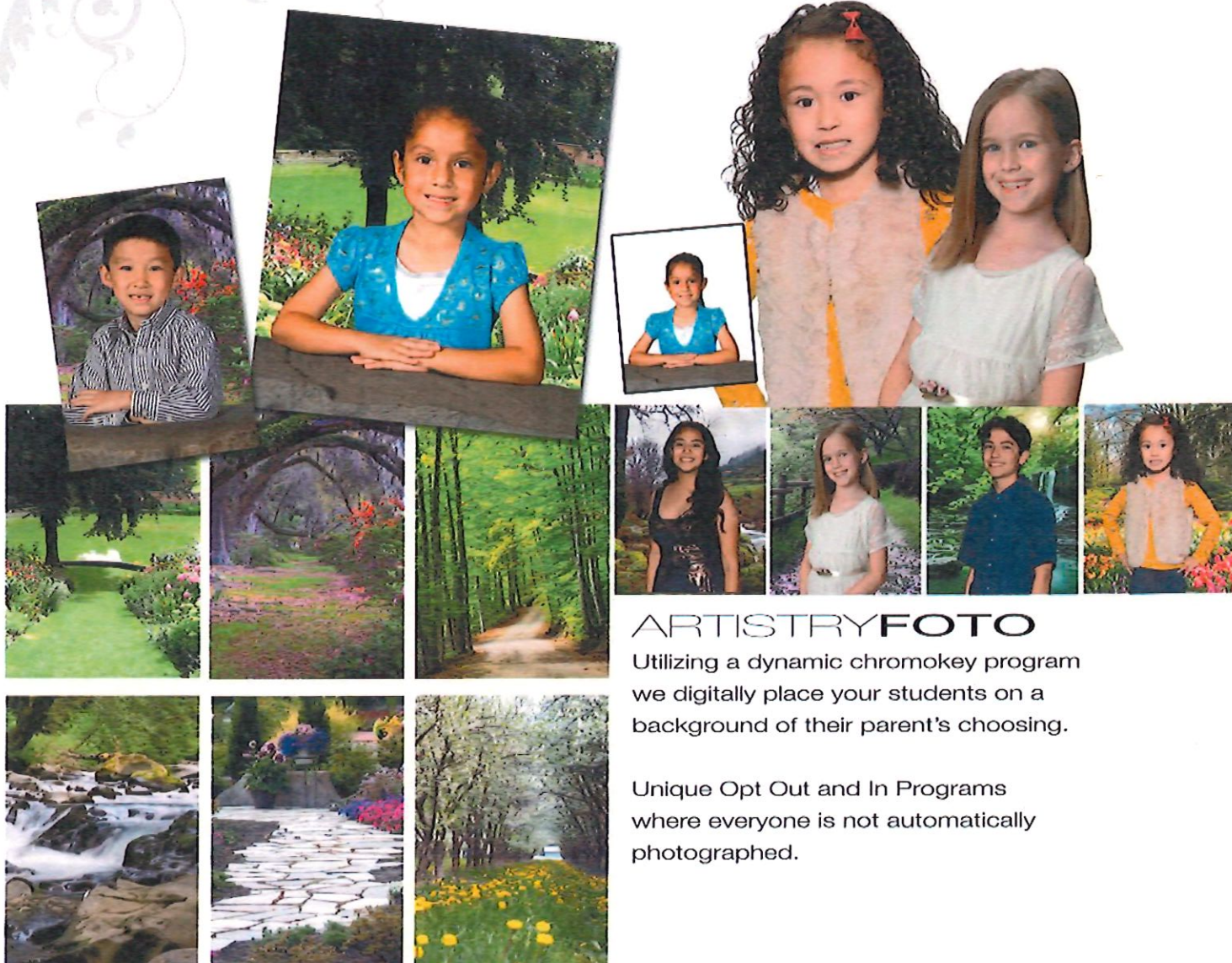
