#### A-GREQUIREMENTS

Students who have met all requirements to attend a UC or Cal State will receive a light blue cord to signify this accomplishment. These seniors wear this cord at the graduation ceremony.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S HONOR ROLL

This honor is presented to the highest achieving seniors. In order to be awarded, a student must have no grade less than an A- in any course during freshman, sophomore, and junior years (straight A's in grades 9-11). These seniors wear a multi-color cord at the graduation ceremony.






### PRINCIPAL'S HONOR ROLL

This honor is presented to students who maintain an overall 3.5-3.74 GPA for the first seven (7) semesters with a minimum of four graded classes each semester. These seniors are recognized at our Annual Senior Awards Ceremony and receive a certificate.

#### CUMLAUDESOCIETY

Cum Laude, (Latin for "with praise") recognizes seniors who have maintained high grades in a rigorous college preparatory program where the students have completed the A-G requirements with a 3.75 + GPA or greater with no D's or F's in any course for seven (7) semesters. Members of the society have their names noted in the commencement program, receive a certificate at our Annual Senior Awards Ceremony, have Cum Laude printed on their diploma, and wear a silver cord at the graduation ceremony. The senior Cum Laude speaker at graduation is selected from this elite group.






## THE STATE SEAL OF BILITERACY

The State Seal of Biliteracy is an award given to students who have studied and attained proficiency in English and one or more other languages by high school graduation. Students must meet GPA, state testing, and language class requirements to qualify. This award is to help students recognize the value of their academic success and see the tangible benefits of being bilingual. These seniors are recognized at our Annual Senior Awards Ceremony, receive a seal on their diploma and wear a gold cord at the graduation ceremony.

# CALIFORNIA SCHOLARSHIP FEDERATION (GRADUATING WITH HONORS IN WHITE GOWN)

The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) supports and encourages academic excellence for students in their sophomore, junior, and senior years. Students are eligible to qualify beginning with their first semester sophomore grades. Students apply at the beginning of each semester. Applications are available from the adviser. Life members will have qualified for four (4) semesters by the end of their senior year. Once seniors qualify for their fourth semester of membership, having to use senior grades, they will be noted in the commencement program, wear a white cap and gown, can purchase a gold cord and stole for the graduation ceremony, receive the emblem on their diploma and final transcript.
