



- Valide las emociones




# ¿Cómo puedo ayudar a mi hijo a desarrollar la conciencia de sí mismo?

- Anime a su hijo a identificar y expresar sus emociones.
- Hable con él/ella sobre las diferentes emociones y sus causas.
- Valide sus sentimientos y se empático con él/ella
- Ayude a su hijo a reflexionar sobre su propio comportamiento y emociones.
- Hable de situaciones en las que manejó bien las emociones o podría mejorar.
- Utilice la narración de historias o el juego de rol para explorar las emociones.
- Fomente una mentalidad de crecimiento, enfatizando la capacidad de aprender y crecer.



# ¿Cómo puedo ayudar a mi hijo a desarrollar el autocontrol?

- Ayude a su hijo a desarrollar sanamente los mecanismos de afrontamiento .
- Analicen positivamente las formas de manejar el estrés o la decepción.
- Fomente algún tipo de pasatiempos o actividades para exteriorizar las emociones
- Enséñele técnicas de atención plena para la autorregulación.
- Practiquen juntos la respiración profunda o la meditación.
- Enséñales a reconocer los factores estresantes y a manejar el estrés con eficacia.



# **¿Cómo puedo ayudar a mi hijo a desarrollar empatía y habilidades sociales?**

- Enseñe la importancia de escuchar con atención y de un ejemplo de escuchar con atención practicando usted mismo.
- Discuta las perspectivas y los sentimientos de los demás.
- Sea voluntario o participe en actividades que promuevan la empatía.
- Fomente actos de bondad y consideración.
- Enseñe a trabajar en equipo y colaborar en actividades que se realicen en grupos.
- Guíe a su hijo a resolver problemas por su cuenta.
- Anímelos a pensar detenidamente en las soluciones.
- Hable sobre las posibles consecuencias de diferentes acciones.
- Sea un buen ejemplo del tipo de comportamiento que desea fomentar.

- Contexto: “La vida cotidiana” – Dentro de la razón/no durante la disciplina
- Escucha activa (no distraída, contacto visual, a su nivel, respuesta)
- Entra en su mundo (aviso y maravilla). Su mundo es importante.
- Pide llamar la atención
- Empatía (“Eso debe haberte lastimado/hecho emocionarte...”)
- Escucha con un “óido interno”. A veces “eso” no es lo “suyo”.
- Encuentra su mejor momento / modo de comunicación
- (en paseos, hombro a hombro, durante las comidas,
- Mientras se acurrucan, antes de acostarse, etc.)
- ¡Disfratalos! ¡Míralos! ¡Ríete y baila con ellos!







