Edison Academy Cell Phone and Electronic Device Policy

Students are expected to demonstrate responsibility when using school issued electronic devices on school property. In the event a student possesses a personal cell phone or electronic communication device, the following policy will be enforced:

- Students may **NOT** use electronic communication devices any time within the school gates except when permitted by a staff member or administrator (cell phones, headphones, earbuds, smart watches, or any Bluetooth enabled device).
- Electronic communication devices must have all notifications silenced and put away on your person, backpack or in a personal belonging.
- Students may **NOT** use electronic communication devices in any way or under any circumstances which infringe upon the privacy rights of other students or adults.
- Students are responsible for personal electronic communication devices brought to school. The school and district will not be responsible for loss, theft, or destruction of any such device brought onto school property. It is the responsibility of the school to ensure the safekeeping of any confiscated devices. Confiscated devices will be stored by school employees in a secure manner.
- Violations of this policy shall be subject to the school's progressive discipline plan.

Consequences for not following the cell phone and electronic device policy:

1st	Verbal warning and documentation sent to the office.
2nd	Parent/Guardian is contacted the day of violation. Item will be confiscated and returned to the student at the end of the day.
3rd	Parent/Guardian is contacted the day of the violation. Item will be confiscated and picked up by parent/guardian during office hours or from THINK Together coordinator.
4th	Parent/Guardian is contacted the day of the violation. Item will be confiscated and picked up by parent/guardian during office hours or from THINK Together coordinator.
5th	Parent/Guardian is contacted. Student loses the privilege of bringing personal electronic devices while on campus or attending school related functions.

Edison Academy Dress Code Policy

1. Shoes must be securely fastened and worn at all times. Flip flops, backless, open-toed shoes/sandals, or Crocs are prohibited. Heels, platforms, or wedges greater than 2 inches in height are prohibited.
2. Clothing must generally conceal undergarments and the stomach when walking normally. See-through tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, off-the-shoulder tops, low-cut tops, crop tops, or shirts with large arm holes are prohibited.
3. Bottoms should fully cover the buttocks when moving. Bottoms must be worn securely, and undergarments should not be visible.
4. Headwear shall not pose a distraction to others or the instructional program. Headwear shall be worn in a safe manner and shall not cover the face or obstruct a student's vision.
5. Clothing, jewelry, hats, and personal items (backpacks, fanny packs, gym bags, etc.) shall not depict offensive, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive, or violent content and should be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia that are gang-related, or that contains drug, alcohol, or tobacco company advertising, promotions, and likenesses, or which advocate racial, ethnic, or religious prejudice as determined by site administration.
6. Hairstyles, nails, and makeup shall not pose a distraction to instruction and shall not adversely impact a student's ability to see during the instructional day. Nails should not prohibit full participation in any school activities.
7. Sunglasses shall only be worn outdoors.
8. Any jewelry that may present a safety hazard is not suitable for school.

Consequences for not following the dress code:

1 st	Verbal warning and documentation sent to the outreach office. Change of clothing may be required.
2 nd	Documentation sent to the outreach office. Parent/Guardian is contacted on the day of the violation. Change of clothing may be required.
3 rd	Documentation sent to the outreach office. Parent/Guardian contacted on the day of violation and will be asked to bring appropriate clothing.
4 th	Documentation sent to the outreach office. Parent/Guardian contacted on the day of violation and will be asked to bring appropriate clothing.
5 th	Documentation sent to the outreach office. Parent/Guardian contacted on the day of violation and a meeting with parent/guardian will be scheduled to determine the next steps.

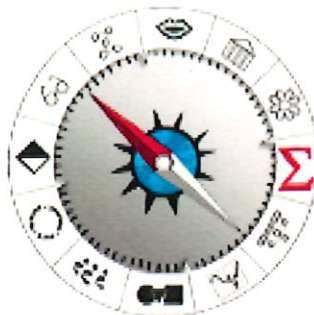

MIDDLE SCHOOL PE LOCKER CONTRACT 7TH-8TH Grade

Edison students are expected to be dressed for PE and have the opportunity to use a school locker in the MPR for the purpose of storing their PE clothes and personal (PE related) items during the week.

Physical Education Dress Requirements for 7th – 8th Grade Students:

1. Students are expected to dress in Physical Education Uniform daily.
2. Students and families will have the opportunity to purchase PE uniforms during Back to School Night and in the main office prior to dress out days.
3. Students will be issued a school lock and locker.

Students are expected to:

1. Store their PE clothes in their locker during the week.
2. Store their school clothes in their locker during their PE class.
3. Take their PE clothes home every Friday, wash them, and return them to school on Monday.
4. Lockers should be locked in the open position over the weekend for cleaning purposes.
5. Write down their combination in their agenda or in another safe/confidential place.
6. Keep their lock and PE items in the locker that is assigned to them.

Students are prohibited from the following:

1. Students may not put any stickers, mirrors, papers, etc. on the inside or outside of their locker.
2. Students may not write or draw on the inside or outside of their locker.
3. Students may not keep items in their locker that are not allowed at school.
4. Students may not keep food in their locker.

If there is a reasonable suspicion of what is stored inside a student's locker, Administrators can open lockers for inspection. Students who do not maintain their PE locker contract may have their privileges of having a PE locker at school taken away. Students and families will be liable for damages to any PE lockers that are not left in the same condition at the end of the year.

Eligibility

- Any major Office Discipline Referrals (ODR's) and suspensions will be reviewed by administration.
- No more than 3 minor ODR's (office discipline referrals) given for violating school-wide expectations.
- No outstanding detentions-tracked with classroom behavior logs.

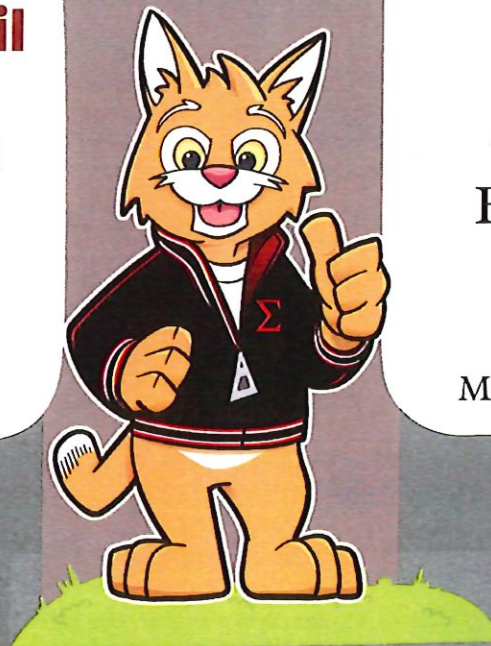
