



Qualities of an Edison Athlete

- Good character in and out of class so that participation in a sport may continue
- Respectful to other students, players, coaches, and referees
- Showing honesty and integrity by following all game rules
- Showing positivity and support for your teammates throughout games and practices
- Being responsible by attending all games and practices
- Being prepared by bringing all equipment and uniform for game days
- Communicating with your coach about any needs you may have, medical changes, or scheduling problems

Please remember that this is a team sport so it is understood that everyone will work together to demonstrate good sportsmanship and respect any decisions made by coaches that will benefit the team as a whole rather than individual students. Students who choose not to participate in a respectful and responsible way may be removed from individual games or (if warranted) the team altogether.

Eligibility

The following requirements must be maintained for the duration of the participating season in Athletics:

- Students must not have D's and F's in classes. You will be ineligible to play in games.
- Any major Office Discipline Referrals (ODR's) and suspensions will be reviewed by administration.
- No more than 3 minor ODR's (office discipline referrals) given for violating school-wide expectations.
- No outstanding detentions-tracked with classroom behavior logs.
