

- Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS)

- Explicitly teach behavior
- Clear expectations
- PBIS points used as reward

Dress Code

- **Clothing:** Must conceal undergarments and stomach at all times. No spaghetti straps, tank tops or crop tops. Pants must be worn at waist.
- **Shorts/Skirts:** Must cover full curve of the buttocks when walking, sitting reaching or bending.
- **Shirts:** No inappropriate designs and/or messages on shirts, regardless of cover-up garments.

Dress Code continued...

• **Shoes:** No sandals, thongs, flip-flops, open-toed, backless shoes, including crocs (in sport mode).

• **Hair/Nails**: Should support full participation all school activities to support a focus on learning.

• **Jewelry**: Safety first.
