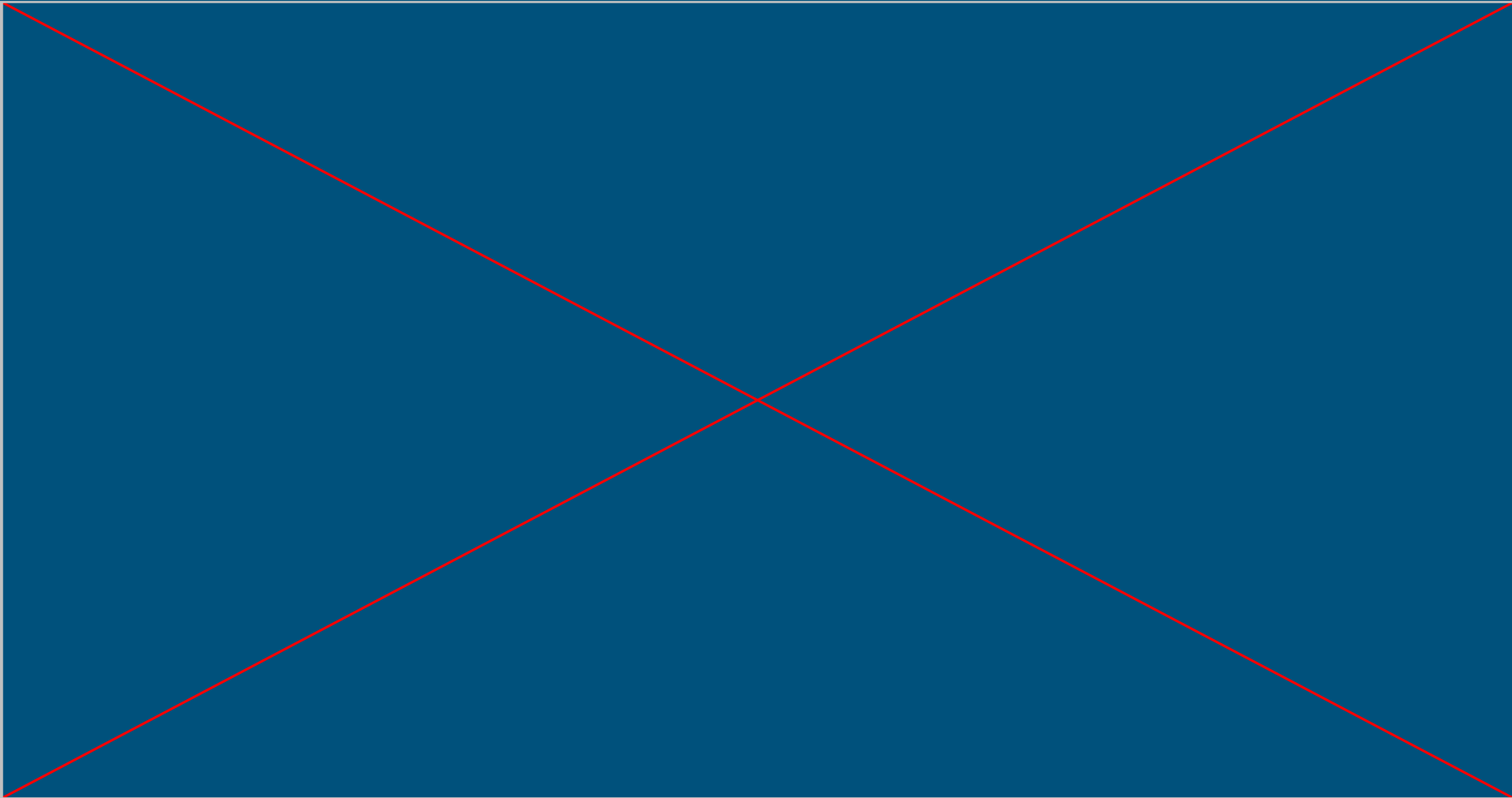

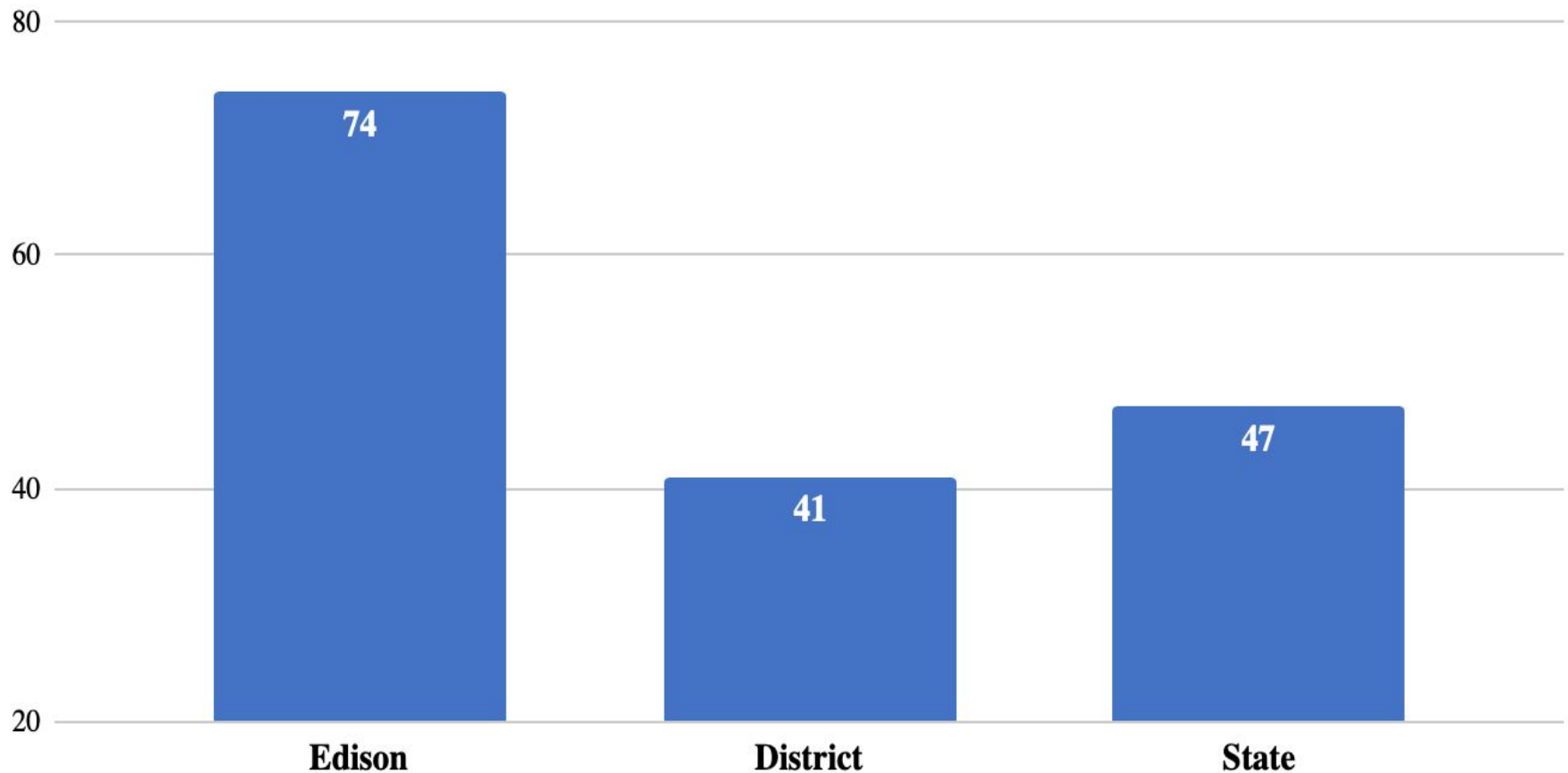

Academic Results: English Language Arts

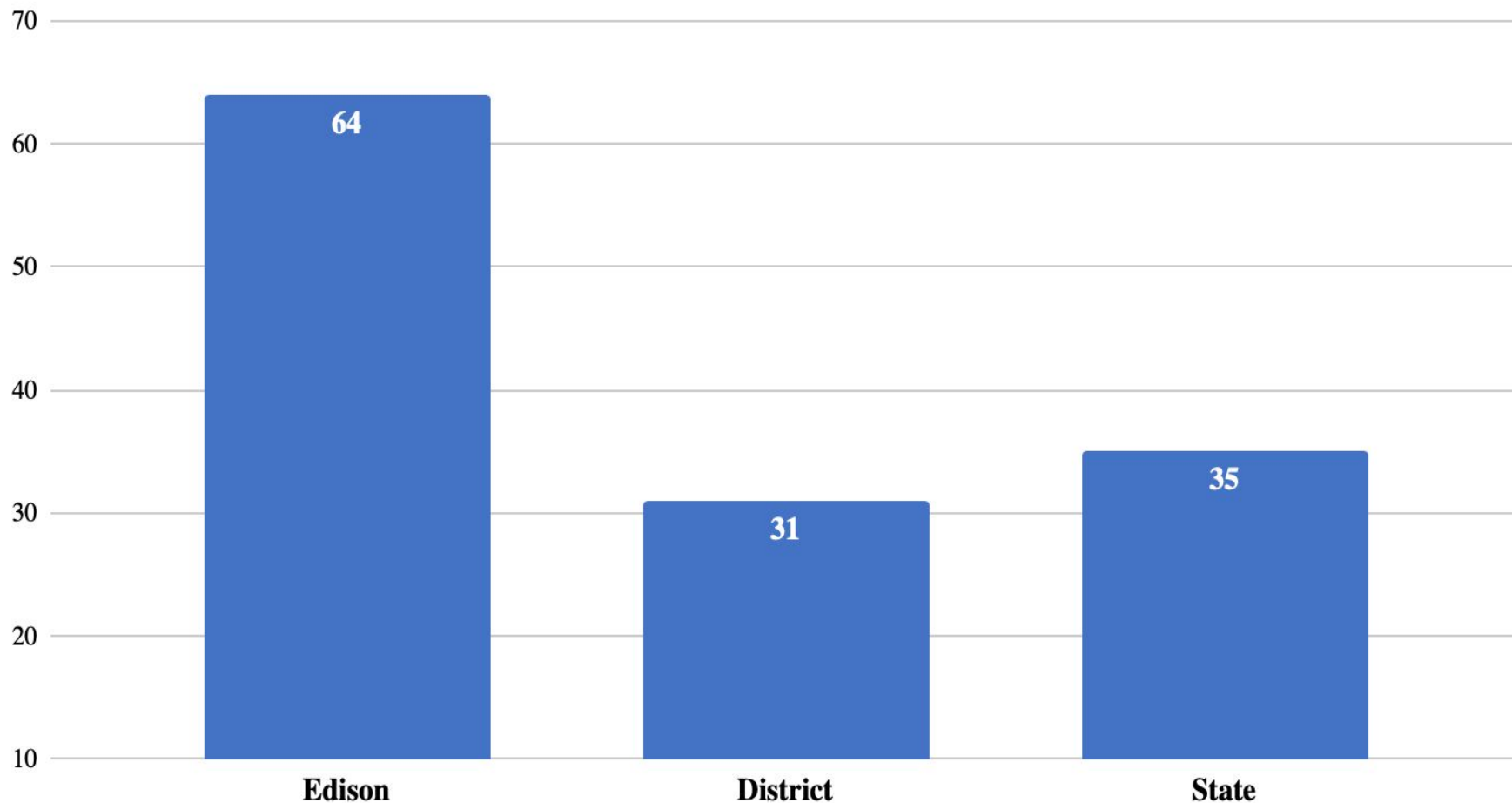
2025 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)

For a Safe Curbside Drop-Off

- Sixth Street / Sultana is for drop off only
 - No parking on school-side curbs
 - Closed parking lot
- Edison staff will be visible in drop off area
- Pull all the way forward in line
- Students exit curbside
 - Infant car seats should go behind driver

For a Safe Gate Drop-Off

- Plan to arrive early - do not rush
- Plan to use the crosswalk on Sixth and Sultana
- Park with this intersection in mind
- Avoid walking through parked vehicles
- Walk students to the front gate

Afternoon Pick Up

- Dismissal
 - 2:40 p.m.
 - 1:25 p.m. (Tuesday)
- 1st-4th Grade: dismissed on Sixth Street
- 5th - 6th Grade: dismissed on Sultana

Many families park on the south side of Sixth Street or on Sultana South of the intersection or North of the pick up area.

Students should walk directly home. Two crossing guards are stationed at Sixth and Sultana.

Perseverance, Unity, Respect, Responsibility

- Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS)
- Focus on the whole child
- Explicitly teach expected behavior
- Clear expectations
- PBIS points used as reward



Dress Code

- **Clothes:** must conceal undergarments and stomach when walking normally. No spaghetti straps, off-the-shoulder, low cut, or crop tops. Pants must be worn at waist
- **Shorts/Skirts:** Must cover when moving normally
- **Shirts:** No inappropriate designs and/or messages on shirts, regardless of cover-up garments

Dress Code continued...

- **Shoes:** No sandals, flip-flops, open-toed, or backless shoes, including crocs (even in sport mode)
- **Hair/Nails:** Should support full participation all school activities to support a focus on learning
- **Jewelry:** Safety first

Cell Phone & Electronic Devices

- Put away and on silent mode
- Honor the privacy the others (no recording)
- Enforce home-school communication
- Teach appropriate digital citizenship
