1. 3. Achieve technological competency and access for our students, staff, and parents to support learning, assessment, and communication while promoting responsible digital citizenship.
4. Provide resources and intervention tools to identify and address early interventions for the social and emotional needs of our students to promote acceptance and create respectful environments for diversity.
5. Improve and expand programs and services for our students by maintaining fiscal solvency, increasing revenue opportunities, and implementing cost saving initiatives.
