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Dear Parent or Guardian,

As you know, all schools in the Ontario-Montclair School District have been implementing School-wide Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) which is a proactive approach to establishing the behavior supports and social culture needed for all students in a school to achieve social, emotional, and academic success.

This school year, we will be utilizing a universal screener for behavior called the Student Risk Screening Scale (SRSS). This valuable tool is used by teachers which will help identify school-wide behavior and social-emotional supports that can support all students and will help identify students who may be having minor challenges in school, such as following rules and expectations or making friends. Our goal in using this universal screener is to identify school-wide instructional needs, inform the use of teacher-delivered strategies, and identify students who may need additional supports.

In conducting the universal screener for behavior, your child's classroom teacher will review the class roster and identify students who currently may be having difficulties in school. The information is kept confidential and only used to determine instructional needs at the classroom and individual student level. School personnel will contact parents of children who have been identified by their classroom teacher to participate in simple interventions focused on supporting the child in a proactive and positive manner.
