The vision of the competition is to “build a collaborative mathematics community for students and educators in order to support, advocate and influence STEM education in the U.S. to pave the way for the 21st century generation of problem-solvers.”

The math competition began with a 6 week window in which all participants completed a 40 minute/ 40 question timed online test. Only the top 500 scorers move on to the final round in Chicago on Saturday, April 27, 2019. Edison Academy is not only proud of Dylan’s accomplishment, but we can boast the addition of another student, **Nathanael Ulrich**, who is on the waitlist for Chicago, after scoring in the 98th percentile.
