A Message from the Principal...

Dear Families,

It is hard to believe that it is already March!! The month has started with some important news from our Superintendent, Dr. James Hammond. In his Community Constant Contact dated March 1, 2022, Dr. Hammond has announced the following change to our COVID mitigation strategies:

- California is moving from the COVID pandemic to the COVID endemic response. As such, Ontario-Montclair School
 District (OMSD) will remain aligned with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), the San Bernardino
 County Department of Public Health (SBCDPH), CalOSHA and other appropriate agencies.
- Beginning March 12, 2022, face coverings will be strongly recommended, but not required for all school employees and students in OMSD. Although the state of California continues to recommend face coverings in K-12 school settings, the mandates related to indoor mask wearing in school ends.

Upcoming Parent Teacher Conference Week

March also brings our second Parent-Teacher Conference Week, which starts on Monday, March 14 and ends on Friday, March 18. This is an important time for parents to meet with teachers to review student progress during the second trimester and to set new learning goals for the last trimester of the school year. All conferences will be on Zoom.

Please be aware that during conference week, Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 12:00 p.m. each day and students in 1st through 6th grades will be dismissed at 12:45 p.m. We ask that you arrange to pick up your children on time during conference week. After the completion of our conference week, our staff and students will enjoy Spring Break vacation from March 21 to March 25.
