REMINDER—Wednesday P.E. Day!!

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

While we are in the online learning phase, please keep in mind that California Senate Bill 98 requires student attendance for online learning classes. As is the case with in person school, **attendance matters** during online school as well.


We ask that parents keep in mind the following:

- Students should be ready to learn each day at 8:00 a.m.
- Students are required to be present for the entire Zoom session.
- Students should not leave Zoom sessions unless the teacher has scheduled a break or has instructed students to work independently.
- If a student will be absent for the day, we ask that parents call the school office at 909-988-2234 to report any absence.

Student Attendance is also based on completion of independent assignments. If your child does not complete and submit school work, your child will not receive credit for the day.
