High School Credit Program Expectation Acknowledgement

I understand participation in the high school credit program requires students to be committed to the credit earning class and all other academic classes. Taking this class is the equivalent of a high school class in the Chaffey Joint Union High School District. Students will be allowed to withdraw from the class within the first 6 weeks of instruction. After the 6 week window students must complete the class and receive the grade that is earned. I understand the earned credit class is obtained through Chaffey Joint Union High School District and may not qualify as a credit class if the student goes to a high school outside the Chaffey Joint Union High School District. If the student takes the course for a letter grade, the grade earned will be calculated into the student's grade point average for high school. Students taking Math Integrated I will be required to take at least three additional years of Mathematics classes in high school in order to meet graduation requirements. Students taking any of the Spanish classes will be expected to continue their commitment to world languages by taking additional language classes in high school, apply for the Seal of Bi-literacy in high school and commit to 2 additional years of language courses in High School. Also, transportation will not be provided for these classes. Parents will be responsible for transporting their students.
