Sample 90 Minute Day

15 Minutes-

Safely entering class, Review safety protocols, Take attendance, SEL/Advisory type lessons

60 Minutes- CORE Instruction (Assignment Support, Enrichment Lesson, Remediation Lesson, i-READY)

15 Minutes- Clean-up, Advisory type lesson, Start homework, Lunch Provided

- Either In-person or online after 1:30pm- Teachers will be providing further information related to intervention opportunities

Survey Results and Student Groups

- Approximately

7th Grade- Online = 196 AND Blended = 210

8th Grade- Online = 169 AND Blended = 217

- Information provided to teachers/families the week of March 29th
 - Group A- Last names A-L- Blended Learning
 - Group B- Last names M-Z- Blended Learning
 - Group C- Online Only Students

Arrival Procedures

- In-person students may arrive to campus no earlier than 11:30am.
- 7th Grade enters and exits through the front gate.
- 8th Grade enters and exits through the F gate.
- Mr. Paz and Mr. Walters students enter and exits through the front gate.
- Health screenings will take place at the entrance points.
- Students are to report to their classroom area, and wait outside socially distancing until class begins at 12:00pm. Staff will be out supervising during this time.
- Signs with teacher names outside of classrooms.

Dismissal Procedures

- Proctors will bring a sack lunch to classroom between 1:00-1:25pm.
- Students DO NOT eat in class, they take their meal home.
- 7th Grade enters and exits through the front gate.
- 8th Grade enters and exits through the F gate.
- Mr. Paz and Mr. Walters students enter and exits through the front gate.

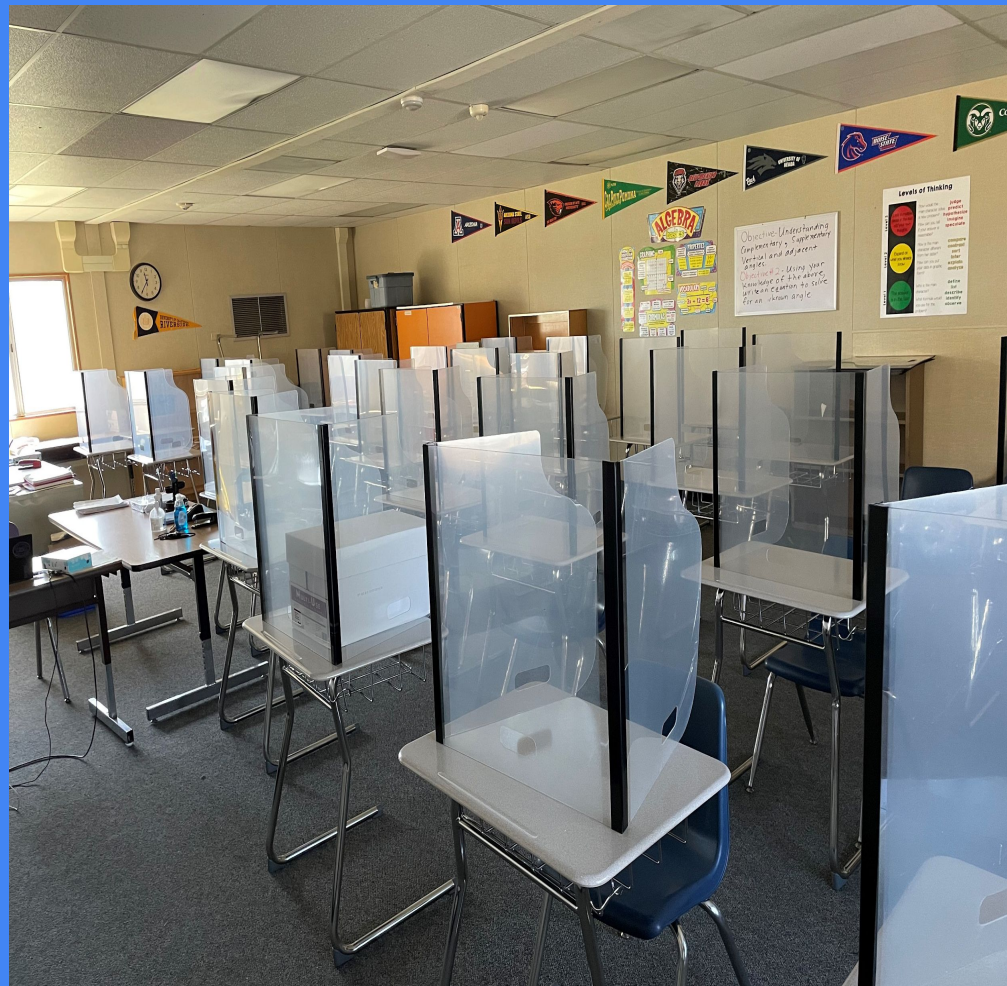


Textbook/Laptop Procedures

- Since it's only 1 period per day teachers will communicate with their class on what to bring on a given day.
- If students are asked to bring a laptop, please ensure they charge it in the morning
- We will be planning a material return date during the last week of school- more info to come.

Sample Classroom Set-Up

- No more than 16 people per classroom
- Social distancing
- Safety Items in all Classrooms:
 - 15 desk guards for student desks
 - Wall mounted hand sanitizer
 - Pack of 50 face masks
 - Floor fan to be used as needed
 - 1 case of water
 - Air purifier system



- **Air Conditioner filters:**

- Replaced/upgraded filters in June 2020 /July 2020
- Another filter replacement cycle is scheduled for April 2021 / May 2021
- Highest rated MERV filters will be installed that HVAC units can comfortably handle

- **Start/End times:**

- HVAC units will be programmed for fans to run to circulate room air for two hours before and after the start and end of school

- **Outside Air:**
 - To increase the amount of outside air entering the classroom, units will be adjusted to increase amount of outside air from 15% to 40%.
- **Room/Portable Air Purifiers**
 - To be provided for each classroom to further filtration of airborne particles in room.

Safety Procedures, PPE, and Cleaning

- Temperature checks/health screenings for all staff and visitors entering campus. All visitors will need to enter campus through the front breezeway for the temperature check/health screening. If an employee or visitor's temperature exceeds 99.9 degrees they will be asked to return home. If an employee or visitor was previously in an overheated environment, temperature re-test may be done in 5-10 minutes.
- The Health Screening questions will be posted on the front door to the office. Every attempt will be made to keep health screenings confidential.

- Face Coverings- Face coverings are required for staff, students, and visitors while in office or campus settings.
- We will ensure a supply of disposable masks is readily available in the event visitor(s) requests/needs/does not have appropriate face covering. Access to visitors (parents, vendors, employees etc.) shall be strictly limited to those who have essential business on campus or in the office.
- Social Distancing- encourage and enforce social distancing protocols for all employees and visitors.

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)- The office has made orders and will supply basic PPE as needed.
- Facilities- All classrooms/offices are disinfected in the afternoon/evening
- Restrooms will be available to all employees and public visitors that have essential business on the premises. Restrooms will be cleaned frequently and in accordance with custodial schedules.

Health Office Procedures

- If a student is sick or in need of the health office, the teacher will contact the front office immediately and someone will come to the class to get the student.
- COVID related issues will be handled by health office staff in the “sick room”.
- All other health related issues will be handled by health office staff in the health office.

Elective/PE Procedures/Computer Lab

- Middle School PE- will be online and In-person based on the blended learning In-Person schedule. Since there is only 1 period per day, students who have PE in person will arrive to school in their PE clothes (comfortable clothes). They will not utilize the locker rooms/dress out on campus. PE will occur on the field and activities planned that can support social distancing.
- Electives- At this time- Band, Chorus, Dance, Drill-will be online and In-person based on the blended learning In-Person schedule. These electives will be held outside as much as possible to support social distancing.
- Computer Lab- Due to the low number of students expected to be on campus, students will be able to utilize the desktops in the lab. Students will be socially distanced and use the same computer each day. Computers will be cleaned after each day.
- Proper arrangements will be made for inclement weather.

Student Supervision

- Support staff and proctors will supervise students during arrival and dismissal.
- Proctors will supervise the quad area from 12:00-12:50 to supervise. They will begin lunch service at 1:00pm.

Uniforms

- No uniforms for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year.
- Students are expected to be dressed appropriately for school.
