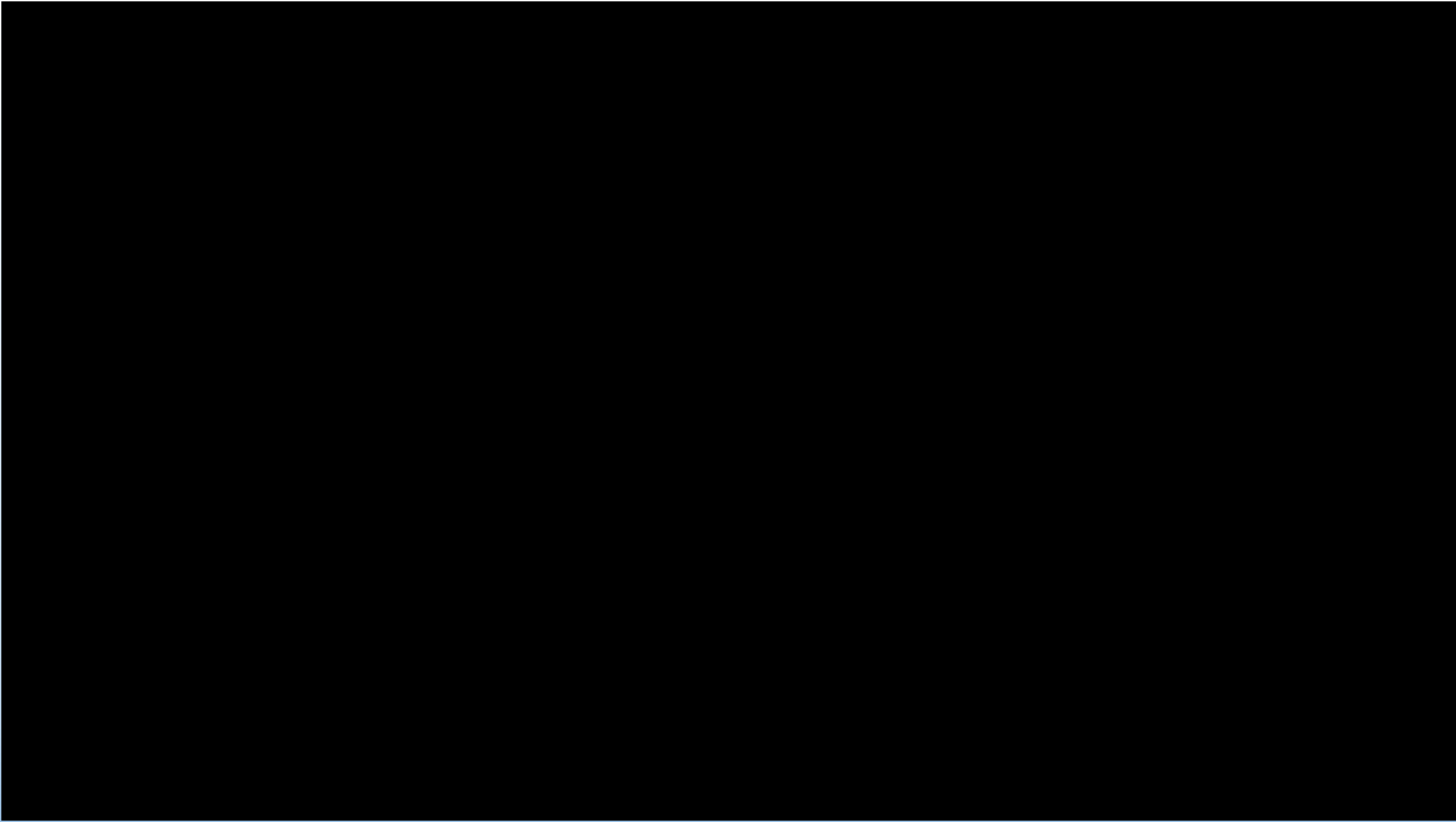

Complete assignments and assessments with the proper resources given by teacher. Share ideas that help others learn and come to answers on their own. Seek help from your teacher or classmates. Take this opportunity to figure out what you know and work on what you do not know. Stay true to your goals. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When on zoom, have your camera and audio turned on. Ensure your username includes your first and last name. Ask questions to ensure you and your classmates understand. Be present and attentive during zoom sessions; reduce any distractions around you during this time. If you are having technology difficulties, use your time to revise notes, read, and use paper and pencil until you are able to resolve the issue. Communicate with your teachers if you have technology issues by calling Serrano Middle School.
Responsibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete required assignments on time. Put your full effort into every assignment. Communicate with your family about your progress and what you need to succeed. Do your work daily. Set up a daily routine, which includes class time as well as practice/homework time. Use all the tools made available to you to enhance your success. Take action to improve at skills you have not yet mastered, part of learning is struggling through difficult tasks. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be on time to your virtual classroom Ensure your computer is charged, powered up, logged on, and connected to the internet before your zoom session begins. Have your materials out and ready before logging on to zoom sessions (Note paper, agenda, pencil, textbooks, etc) Come to zoom sessions prepared with completed assignments. Take notes during zoom sessions. Maintain an academic, professional demeanor during class meetings. Take care of your personal needs during breaks and in between zoom sessions (restroom, water, snacks, etc) Participate fully in zoom sessions, share your ideas!
Compassion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do what you can to make learning meaningful and enjoyable. Be considerate of others thoughts and ideas. Support classmates who may need help accessing online materials. Show compassion by assisting others when you can and accepting help when needed. Keep a growth mindset for yourself and towards others. (If you are not there <u>yet</u>, you will get there!) Reach out and ask for support if you or a peer are having a hard time socially or emotionally.
