Continuum of Special Education Services and Program Options

Most **Home Hospital** Restrictive Services are provided in home for either general ed. or special ed. students. **Residential School** Student receives special ed. and related services from specially trained staff in a residential facility. **Alternative Placement** Student recieves special ed. and related services by specially trained staff in a specially designed facility (day program). Separate Classroom Student attends a separate class for most or all the school day receiving special education instruction with possible related services. **Resource Room** Student is in the gen. ed. classroom for the majority of the school day but goes to the special education resource room for specialized instruction for part of the school day. Regular classroom with supplementary instruction and services Student receives a core-curriculum based program under the direction of the gen. ed. teacher and also receives instruction and related services within the general ed. classroom from the special educator and/or paraeducator. Least **Regular Classroom with Consultation** Student receives a core-curriculum based program under the direction of the regular classroom Restrictive teacher, who is supported by ongoing consultation from the special educator(s).
