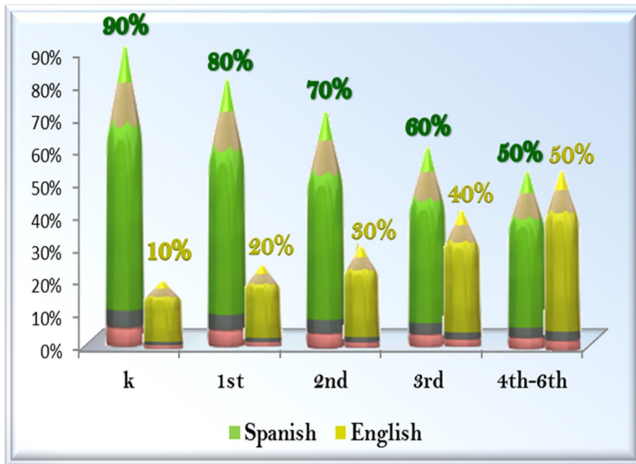


What does a Dual Language Immersion Program offer?

This unique program offers English and Spanish speaking students the opportunity to learn and excel in two languages, English and Spanish.

Students in a Dual Language Immersion Program are taught in the 90/10 model. Students in kindergarten receive 90% of their instruction in Spanish and 10% in English. Each subsequent year, English is gradually increased into the program. By 4th-6th grade instructional time will be 50% in Spanish and 50% in English.

***All instruction (Except 10%) and assessments are in Spanish. ***
