Goal Setting

Why start goal setting with your child? There are many benefits to goal setting in elementary school. Goal setting can help teach the value of working hard toward a goal in the future and delaying gratification until getting there. It also teaches children the value of responsibility and time management. With pursuing a goal, children grow in perseverance and develop grit. Lastly, goal setting gives a child greater self-confidence; with every accomplished goal, your child will grow with a sense of accomplishment and have greater confidence in his or her abilities.



SEL

• Take some time with your student/s to make a gratitude list. The items listed do not have to be extravagant things, it can be as simple as being thankful for "food, a blanket, family, etc." Discuss why you guys are grateful for those things and how you can show more appreciation.
