

# CALIFORNIA MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING LAWS

## ORGANICS

**Assembly Bill 1826** requires certain commercial businesses and multi-family properties to have recycling collection services. Those services include mandatory collection of organic materials such as food scraps, food-soiled paper and landscape trimmings.

**WHAT'S NEW?** Businesses that generate 2 cubic yards or more of solid waster per week must have organics recycling services. Organics include food, yard trimmings, nonhazardous wood, and food-soiled paper.

**WHAT CHANGED?** Businesses that generate 2 or more cubic yards of solid waste (trash) per week are required to subscribe to organics recycling.
