At Sultana, we teach students to be SAFE, RESPONSIBLE, and RESPECTFUL in all areas on campus. We also use positive language to communicate our behavior expectations. For example, we will instruct students to "walk in the hallway" instead of telling them "not to run." Research shows that when you tell a student NOT to do something, they are more likely to do it. Instead we explicitly tell them what we WANT them to do. Try this at home and let us know how it works for you!!

Each year within the first twenty days of school, the California State Department of Education sends an inspection team to each elementary school.

The team checks to make sure that students have enough text books and that the school is clean and safe for the students. Our school received a 100% score in all areas!

Make Arrival and Dismissal Safe for our Students!

Please help us keep our students safe by observing our arrival and dismissal policy. Supervision begins at 7:30 am for students, so please drop-off your students at between 7:30-7:55 so they may be in their seats and ready to learn at 8:00 am. in addition, students are to be picked-up promptly at their dismissal time.

Vehicles may use the front of school drive-through lane to drop-off and pick-up students. To increase efficiency, please be sure to constantly move your vehicle up through the drop-off/pick-up lane, and never leave your vehicle unattended. In addition, all parked vehicles must be parked in a parking spot or on the street. Please do not block any parked vehicles by parking behind them.

We encourage you to talk with your student about what gate to use at dismissal.

Please help keep our students safe by escorting them across street intersections. Our kids safety is top priority, but we need your help! If you have questions, please ask your child's teacher or stop by the office. We are here to help!
