Helping Your Child Set & Track Goals

Goal-setting is a powerful way for children to take ownership of their learning. Here's a simple routine you can try together at home:

- Pick one small goal (1–2 weeks). Example: read 15 minutes each night.
- Make it measurable. "I will read 5 nights this week."
- Choose the strategy. "I'll set a timer at 7:00 p.m. each night."

The words we use can shape how children see themselves as learners. Try these simple swaps to encourage a growth mindset:
