A Message from the Principal...

Dear Kingsley Families,

Happy New Year! We hope you were able to have the best break and holiday season possible with your family. We at Kingsley are excited to be getting back to school and learning, and we wish you and yours a very healthy and safe 2021.

On Friday, January 8th, Kingsley will hold another Grab and Go in our front traffic circle. This will be similar to other "drive through" models used for meals and distributions we have had in the past. There's no need to exit your car; just provide your child's teacher's name and your child's name. After, we will hand you the next set of textbooks and materials students will need through the end of February, as well as school picture orders and student ID cards. Should you not have access to a car, we will also have an area for pedestrians. Thank you for remembering to wear a mask and practice social distancing. If you are ill, please call the office and we will find another way to get materials to your family. Our schedule will be by student last name so families with multiple children will only need to come once. Should you have children with different last names, please choose one time slot that is most convenient for you.

January is the month we review our PBIS Behavior Expectations with our students. We will be giving them reminders on what it means to be a Kingsley Lion who is Respectful, Responsible and Compassionate. One of our topics will be showing the Big 3 during synchronous, or live, instruction.

Also coming up this month is our second iReady Diagnostic Test. The computer program correctly places students in lessons based on their scores used by this important test. While it can be very tempting to help students with this test, please only provide words of encouragement like "I love how hard you are working; you are being so responsible!" or ensure they know how to click to answer questions. If you are interested in learning more about this intervention program, please join us for Coffee with the Principal on January 28th. We ask that students spend 15 minutes each school day in both ELA and Mathematics to support our teachers in filling any gaps students might have as well as accelerating those who are ready for the next step in their lessons. Reading twenty-thirty minutes each day is also an important task to keep those reading skills going. Additionally, we offer RAZ-Kids as an electronic reading resource. Please talk to your child's teacher if you need support accessing either program.

Finally, please remember how important good attendance is during these winter months. We need our students joining us on Zoom every day, on time, and for their entire sessions. We know this is a difficult season for our Kingsley Community, and we are thankful for your amazing and continued support at home. Together, we will come out stronger on the other side of this pandemic.
