This is a very exciting time of the year. Please remember that behavior and academic performance are huge determinants in eligibility for participation in end of the year activities.

There are several end of the year activities planned for Oaks students. These include field day, eighth grade field trips, and the eighth grade dance. The following criterion are requirements for a student to participate in the end of the year activities at Oaks Middle School (may differ from other middle schools in the district):

No more than two or more F’s from the last grading period from two or more teachers.

2.0 cumulative GPA .

No administrative suspensions (in house or home) incidents during the second semester

No involvement in the pre-expulsion process.

No more than 3 or more incidents of administrative suspensions (and/or 7 cumulative suspension days) throughout the school year.

No unresolved truancies or detentions.
